HOW TO GET TO THE ONE KING WEST HOTEL

One King West Hotel is located at the south west corner of Yonge St. and King St. W. It is a short drive (5 min) or walk (10 min) from Union Station, the largest and busiest rail terminal in Canada.





HOW TO GET TO UNION STATION

FROM PEARSON AIRPORT



Taxi/ Ride Share

If you use the ride sharing apps Uber, Lyft or Facedrive, you can request a pick-up from Pearson.

Cost: Taxi ~\$70

Ride share: starting at \$40

PRESTO - \$9.25 (tap card before you board) Tickets: You can either buy them online, or from one of the ticket machines at any of the UP Express stations. They take cash, credit and

USING THE TRANSIT (TTC) ←

The **Toronto Transit Commission (TTC**) is the public transport agency that operates bus, subway, streetcar, services in Toronto.

Closest station to hotel: King Station (Line 1/Yonge-University Line)

How to pay for transit: PRESTO Tickets

One-ride, two-ride and day pass PRESTO Tickets are available for sale from the Fare Vending Machine at all TTC stations or at Shoppers Drug Mart.

Tap your PRESTO Ticket or Card to enter any TTC subway station, streetcar or bus and to transfer. Keep it with you as you ride as your proof of purchase for TTC fare inspections.

Cost: one-ride ticket costs \$3.35

two-ride ticket costs \$6.70

day pass (unlimited trips in 1 day) ticket costs \$13.50

Note: PRESTO has cards that are reloadable and can be used to pay your fare on the TTC, GO Transit, UP Express and 8 other transit agencies in Ontario.

A card cost \$4. The savings for an adult using a PRESTO card compared to buying tickets are minimal. Only worth it to purchase a card if you are living in an area with transit that accepts PRESTO and use transit regularly.
